

## Key Stage 1 attainment

---

2016 is the first year of the new key stage 1 tests in maths and English reading. There is no test in science at key stage 1. This year's tests are the first to reflect the new primary curriculum, which was introduced in 2014. Because this is the first year of the new assessment frameworks, the results will look very different from those of previous years, and should not be compared with them. The expectations for pupils at the end of key stage 1 have been raised. Given the differences in the curriculum and assessments, levels are not comparable with the teacher assessment outcomes.
