Week 1 & 2

Friday 1st September is a Training Day - school closed to children. Monday 4th to Tuesday 12th September - Home Visits for all Reception parents.

Weeks 2

Wednesday 13th to Friday 15th September - Children in morning (**Apple Tree Class - D.O.B 1st September to 21st February 2013. Cherry Tree Class Class - D.O.B 1st September to 28th February 2013**) or afternoon (D.O.B 1st March to 31st August 2013). Pick up from classroom door (11.30am for morning sessions and 3.15pm for afternoon sessions)

Week 3 & 4

Monday 18th to Wednesday 27th September - All children in for mornings and lunch. 1.15pm pick up from classroom door. From Thursday 28th September - Full time. 3.15pm pick up from classroom door.

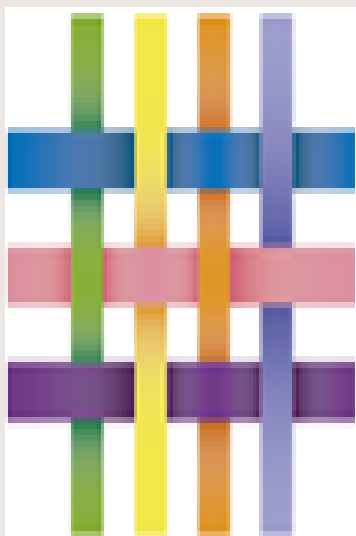

What can you do to help get your child ready for school?

- **Encouraging independence!**
- Encourage your child to talk!
- Sharing books, talking about the pictures.
- Encourage mark making, shopping lists etc.
- Practise counting at any time - climbing the stairs, shopping etc.
- Play simple board games.
- Sing number rhymes and songs together.
- Dressing independently, including putting on shoes.
- Practise doing up coats!
- Use a knife and fork properly.
- Manage going to the toilet and washing hands independently.
