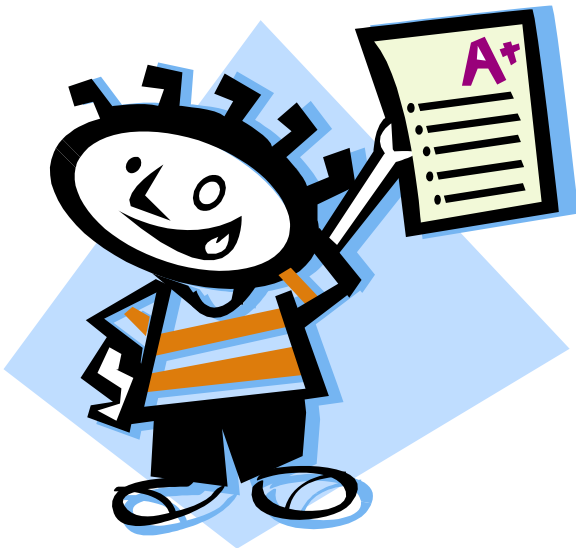

# Year 4 Expectations

- ▶ Reading: 5 times a week for 20 mins recorded in their reading logs.
- ▶ X tables: 12x12 by the end of year 4.

# Expectations from Maths Curriculum

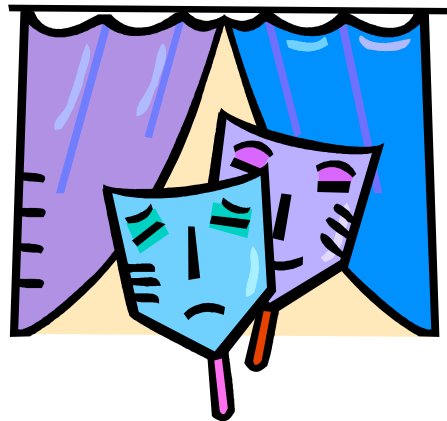
- ▶ Some targets are:
  - Know all tables to 12x12.
  - Secure place value to 10,000.
  - Use negative whole numbers.
  - Round numbers to 10 and 100
  - Use Roman numerals to 'C' (100).
  - Column addition/subtraction to 4 digits.
  - Multiply/divide mentally.
  - Use standard short multiplication.
  - Find area.
  - Calculate perimeter.
  - Identify angles. Identify symmetry.
  - Recognise 10<sup>th</sup>s and 100<sup>th</sup>s.
  - Add and subtract fractions.
  - Round decimals.

# Expectations from Literacy Curriculum

- ▶ Mixed discussion groups for guided reading sessions.
- ▶ Think Aloud promotes independence in discussion of reading.
- ▶ Reading across a variety of reading materials.
- ▶ Promoting a love of reading.
  
- ▶ Extra detail in sentences- fronted adverbials
- ▶ More adventurous vocabulary
- ▶ Higher level structured sentences- embedded clauses
- ▶ Greater consideration to the reader. Choosing words, tenses and sentence types to create atmosphere across the whole text.
  
- ▶ Punctuation : ; ... ‘ “ “ ( )
