# Primary PE and sport funding - accountability measures.

**Impact 2013-14**

*“Ofsted will monitor the impact of this funding on primary PE and school sport and report on its findings.”*

From September 2013, Ofsted has strengthened its coverage of PE and sport as well as considering how effectively schools have used their additional funding. The impact of the funding will be considered in terms of:

- achievement in weekly PE lessons;
- increased participation in competitive school sport;
- personal health and well-being; and
- improved attitudes and behaviour towards learning.

At Hartley Primary Academy, we provide the children with 2 hours of high quality PE lessons per week. The children also have the opportunity to attend many sporting clubs which promote physical activity, personal health and well being and many of these clubs quite often lead to competitive sport.

In November 2013 – we employed a qualified coach from JG Played to support our teachers on a rota basis on any aspect of PE that the teachers felt would develop their own CPD within the PE curriculum.

Mrs A Rezki is a very experienced PE teacher and has so far taken classes in Year 1, 2, 3, and 5 in gymnastics and dance. She has also provided opportunities for outdoor education for years 2, 5 and 6 and inspired the whole school to participate in orienteering across all year groups for our Sports Relief Day.

In term 6, Mrs Rezki will teach tennis with Year 4 and Outdoor Pursuits/Team building activities with Year 6

These have been put into the planning file on the system.</li> <li>• Teachers are shown how to lead effective warm ups as well as demonstrations on how to deliver movements correctly.</li> <li>• Teachers have developed confidence and knowledge on how to deliver gymnastic and dance lessons well and will be observed by either the PE co-ordinator or the specialist teacher.</li> <li>• All lessons were led by specialist teacher – providing high quality training and expert advice for teachers.</li> <li>• Teachers have had the opportunity to observe and assess each child’s progress and development.</li> <li>• Teachers were able to take notes and observe good practice of vocabulary and movement phrases used in practice.</li> </ul>
