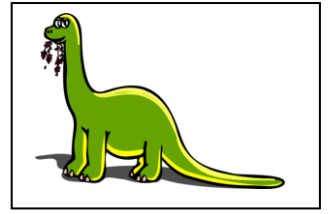


## Year 1: Term 4 Learning

Our theme this term is Dinosaur Discoveries.



**English:** We will be reading a range of stories about Dinosaurs. We will continue to look at the structure of stories, punctuation, adjectives, connectives and also continue with progression with handwriting. We are focusing on developing spelling within our writing



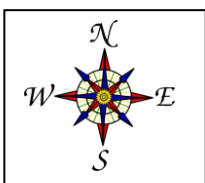
and Phonics lessons. Children will read weekly within our Guided Reading sessions, where we focus on Comprehension skills and reading with intonation and pace, as well as recognising the words being read aloud.

**Maths:** Areas we will cover will be measuring lengths: in cm and metres as well as non-standard units like cubes. Capacity, handling data, money, addition and subtraction will be covered. Counting in 2's, 5's, 10's is being continued also.



**Science:** As the Seasons change we will be examining what happens and looking at the changes as we welcome Spring. Alongside our Dinosaur topic we will let the children experiment with classifying, grouping and comparing dinosaurs. They will be encouraged to discuss what they have done, how and why; and to record their work.

**PE:** Our PE will continue on a Tuesday and Thursday. Please remember to still send outdoor winter kit: jogging bottoms, top, trainers and gloves. This term can still be very cold. As before, please pack a spare pair of socks and make sure everything is clearly named.



**Geography:** We will be looking at the School grounds and the building, using aerial views. We will focus on using directions too: left, right, forward, backwards, N,S,E,W.

**Art, DT, Music, ICT:** (including Internet Safety) will be linked in with our Dinosaur Discoveries Topic.
